What is it?

This three-session parent/child workshop, facilitated by drama teacher and behavior therapist, Tina Ulrich, will explore the use of drama-based games and activities designed for parents and children (ages 3-5) on the autism spectrum. Participants will be asked to complete brief pre- and post-session interviews about their experience with the program. All information will be kept confidential, and no names will be shared with any other agency.

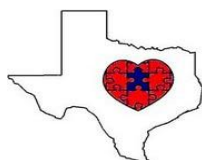
